

# Notes on seasons and weather

\*En (el invierno, el verano, la primavera, el otoño) = in (season)

\*When talking about the weather, use 3rd person singular form of hacer:

hace buen tiempo = *it's making good weather*

hace mal tiempo = *it's making bad weather*

hace sol = *it's making sun*

hace frío = *it's making cold*

\*To say that it's raining or snowing

está lloviendo = *it's raining (now)*

está nevando = *it's snowing (now)*

## Notes on seasons and weather

\*For a general statement about the rain/snow, use the 3rd person singular of *llover* or *nevar*.

Ejemplos:

Llueve poco en el desierto. = *It rains very little in the desert.*

Nieva mucho en Buffalo. = *It snows a lot in Buffalo.*

\*The seasons in South America are the opposite of those in North America.

\*Temperature in Celsius is standard in the Spanish-speaking world.

$$F^{\circ} = 9/5 C^{\circ} + 32$$
